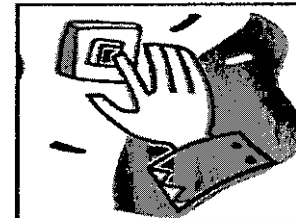


**Cell Phones/I Pods at Westview**

**Safe ARRIVAL**

At Westview Public School, one of our greatest priorities is ensuring that all our students arrive safely at school each and every day.

The new SafeArrival system will reduce the time it takes to verify student attendance, and make it easy for you to report your child's absence.

**There are 3 convenient methods to report your child's absence:**

1. Using your mobile device ,download and install the SchoolMessenger App from the Apple Store or Google Play Store.
2. Use the SafeArrival website, <https://go.schoolmessenger.ca> Sign-up to create your account. Select Attendance then Report an Absence.
3. Call the toll-free number 1-833-309-1241

These options are available 24 hours/day, 7 days per week. Future absences can be reported at any time.
