New Report Card Information - Report cards will be sent home on Monday, November 30th

The Ministry of Education has implemented a new information system called My Schools Sask (MSS) for all school divisions in the province. As a result, our report card will look different for the 2020-2021 school year. The report card will continue to provide parents and students with a summary of the students' progress and growth with respect to subject grade

understand and do in a subject area for their grade level. In the past, we have reported on the strands of a subject, such as reading, writing, listening, speaking and viewing.

Now, we will report whether a student is beginning, approaching, meeting, or exemplary in their demonstration of learning within subject and grade specific outcomes. Grade 10-12 classes will be assigned a final grade in a percentage as we have in the past. In a few classes, you may notice that a specific outcome is not identified for the subject your child is learning. This is normal and these will be developed and added to the report card by the Ministry of Education. Our goal is to continue to ensure that parents and students understand the progress that the student is making with respect to grade level outcomes.

An online parent/student portal will be coming soon. A report card should confirm all other communication that has happened between students, teachers and parents. Please talk directly with your child's teacher with any questions or concerns that you may have about your child's progress or about the report card itself.
