From here you can sign up to get bus notifications to your phone, check our daily bus report or register a child for busing. Clicking on the word "Transportation" will take you to our main page for even more information.


A friendly reminder that we do not phone individual homes to report bus cancellations. We also ask that you do not call the Transportation Office for this information as we will be very busy managing the routes and ensuring the safety of the children on the buses.

#### Dressed for the season:

Students must dress appropriately for the weather. They must be dressed adequately for a 1 kilometer walk in case of an emergency. Our bus drivers have the authority to warn/educate a student on a first offense, and refuse transportation on the second.
