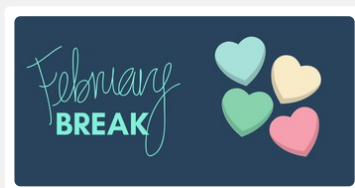
Sweetheart Dance - Friday, February 17th for Kindergarten to Grade 3

Work to ensure that each child has a trusted adult in the school to whom they can speak when a problem occurs.



Attendance Gateway to Excellence

Set a regular bedtime and morning routine. Lay out clothes and pack backpacks the night before.
