**DO NOT** plug ground drain or sprinkler spouts

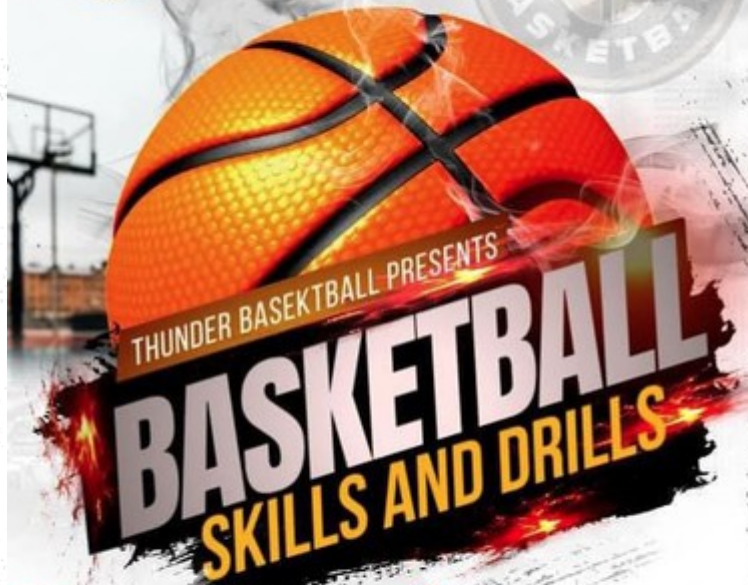
During **JULY & AUGUST** the splash park will be open every day from 10 am until 9pm
