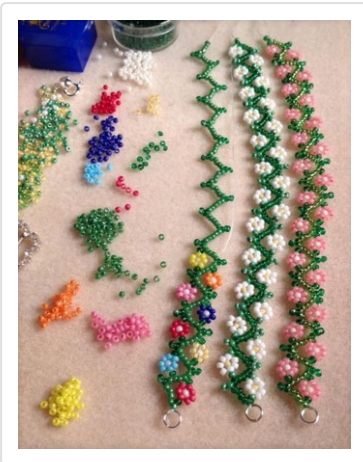
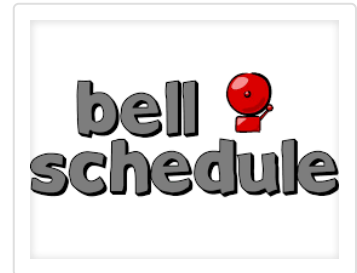
New students and those who were absent on the 2 previous picture days will have the opportunity to have their picture taken on November 7th.

Literacy to Howl About



ZOOPHONICS

Zoo Phonics is a program we use to teach our students letter shapes, names, and sounds.

- The letters are shaped like animals to help students remember the shape and sound of them.
- Letter sounds are taught before letter names because we use the sounds to read words.
- Lowercase letters are taught first because they are easier to form and they are most common in what we read.
